

Wanale Ridge-Sipi Falls Expedition

3 Days Tailor-made adventure road trip | Departure; Any day

Itinerary

Day 01:

Early morning departure (7:00 am) from Kampala headed east of the Country via Jinja Road to Mbale district through verdant countryside, traversing traditional homesteads, farms, and beautiful grasslands and forests.

Uganda's Eastern frontier has broad coverage of plains dotted with extinct volcanoes and isolated mountain ranges. The highest and most extensive of these is the 4000sq km Mount Elgon. In addition, the Sipi River plunges quickly, forming three spectacular waterfalls. On our tour of the Eastern frontier, we will look to explore extensively the breathtaking and scenic beauty of the Eastern region that further contributes to Uganda's beauty.

Upon an afternoon arrival in Mbale district, we will drive straight to the lodge for check-in and freshen up.

Day one activities:

- Hike to the top of one Sipi falls.
- Abseiling
- Kings point (dependent on weather)

Day 02

We will set out for the next day's activities with an early morning rise and breakfast. Activities may include:

- Hiking Wanale Ridge.
- Hike to the last two Sipi falls
- Kings point (if not done on the 1st day)
- Mbale nightlife (if possible).

Day 03

Upon an early morning rise and breakfast, we will set out for our final trip day's activities.

Activities:

- Coffee tour
- Community/nature walk

Late afternoon: End of road trip & drive back to Kampala.
