

Best of three Safari (Serengeti, Ngorongoro & Tarangire)

11 Days Tailor-made safari, Departure; Any day

Over view

This tour offers you a fantastic Tanzania experience. You will visit three of the best National Parks Tanzania has to offer. You will travel to the most remote areas and experience the best wildlife safari adventure.

The tour starts in Arusha, where you will travel to Tarangire National Park, one of Tanzania's most famous national parks. You can find a vast diversity of wildlife, and you can find over 500 bird species. You will stay overnight within the National Park and stay here for three nights.

After Tarangire, you will travel further to the well-known Serengeti National Park. The Serengeti is famous for its annual wildebeest migration, a once-in-a-lifetime experience. And lastly, you will travel to the enormous Ngorongoro Crater for some beautiful nature sightseeing and incredible game drives.

Itinerary:

Day 1: Kilimanjaro airport – Arusha

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro airport, you will be met and transferred to Arusha. Overnight accommodation in Arusha.

Day 2: Arusha – Tarangire National Park

This morning you will travel to Tarangire National Park. Tarangire is one of Tanzania's largest national parks and a sanctuary for a substantial elephant population. Its natural vegetation consists mainly of Acacia woodland, where you can find over 500 bird species, and the majestic African Baobab trees, an exciting feature of the park. Animals concentrate along the Tarangire River, which provides the only permanent water supply in the area, making it the place for many animals and predators. There is a great diversity of wildlife, including lions, leopards, cheetahs, and up to six thousand elephants. Enjoy your afternoon game drive. Overnight within Tarangire National Park.

Day 3: Tarangire National Park

Enjoy a full day of game drives in Tarangire National Park. Tarangire has beautiful scenery and many different areas to explore. Overnight in Tarangire National Park.

Day 4: Tarangire National Park

Another full day allows you to travel to each corner of this park in search of remote animal encounters. Stay overnight in Tarangire National Park.

Day 5: Tarangire – Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, you will commence your drive to one of the most famous game parks in Africa, the Serengeti. The Serengeti is famed for its annual migration, where approximately three million wildebeest, zebra & Thompson's gazelle trek the park in search of fresh grazing. The spectacle of predator versus prey dominates Tanzania's most incredible park. Over the vast flat plains, you will likely find lions, cheetah, leopards, hyenas, and many other small predators.

Enjoy an afternoon game drive, followed by the experience of sleeping in the middle of the Serengeti. Overnight within Serengeti National Park.

Day 6: Serengeti National Park

For a full day within this beautiful park, your guide will choose the best animal spotting locations for that time of year. You can spend time at the Hippo pool, watching these majestic animals laze about in the cool water alongside the crocodiles, watch a considerable pride of lions or be in the middle of the migration. You can journey from the wide-open plains to the kopjes. These rocky volcanic outcrops provide protection and shelter for a wide variety of animals; from the top, we can look out across the vast grasslands of the Serengeti. This diverse and exciting landscape will provide you with the ultimate game viewing. Overnight within Serengeti National Park.

Day 7: Serengeti National Park

You can travel to more remote areas with another full day in the park. While others congregate around central Serengeti, you will travel further into Western, Southern, or Northern Serengeti. Overnight within Serengeti National Park.

Day 8: Serengeti – Ngorongoro Crater

An early morning start in the Serengeti to try and find cats before they retreat away from the blazing sun during the day. After a few hours of game drives in the Serengeti, transfer to the Ngorongoro Crater. Overnight on the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater.

Day 9: Ngorongoro Crater

This morning you will travel to and descend into the Ngorongoro Crater – a wonderful haven for wildlife. Ngorongoro is unique in that almost all the wildlife lives within the crater walls; hence you have the opportunity to find game easily. The crater supports a wide variety of animals, which include herds of wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, eland, warthog, hippo, elephants, and the endangered white rhino. Another big draw card to this picturesque crater is its dense population of predators, which include lions, hyenas, jackals, cheetahs, and occasionally leopards. Enjoy a full-day game drive, including a picnic lunch by the hippo pond, overnight on the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater.

Day 10: Ngorongoro Crater – Arusha

This morning you have the chance to enjoy a walking safari around the rim of the crater. Here you are likely to see a range of small animals, birds, and local flora & fauna. After lunch, commence your drive back to Arusha. Overnight accommodation in Arusha.

Day 11: Departure

Transfer back to Kilimanjaro airport in time for your flight.
